Understanding Loss and Grief in Older Adults

PURPOSE

This workshop will provide knowledge and skills for use with older adults who are grieving. Participants will gain an understanding of societal views of loss and grief, and how personal orientation impacts practice. Attendees will learn how to provide older persons a comfortable space for expressing grief.

DIRECTIONS

Ramada Plaza was formerly Holiday Inn. The I-75 exit is south of I-70 and north of US-35.
