Dying as a Stage of Life: Living into Death

PURPOSE

Attendees will explore death awareness; look at issues facing dying persons and their families, including end-of-life decisions; evaluate the potential for growth at this ending phase of life; examine a variety of cultural and religious beliefs concerning this issue; and study the dynamics of grief and skills to care for both the dying and the grieving.

DIRECTIONS

Take **EXIT 59** off I-75, just south of I-70.

Follow **"To Poe"** signs overhead at exit.

Continue to follow **"To Poe"** signs, turning right onto Poe-Wyse Connector.

Turn right onto Poe Ave. and travel 1.2 mi.

Celebrations II is on the left.

Note: *If using a GPS system, be sure to show the city as Vandalia, not Dayton.*

PLEASE NOTE —

It is difficult to control room temperature to everyone's comfort level. We suggest you dress in layers which can be adaptable to warm and cool temperatures.
